The World Knowledge Forum is a non-profit entity, which aims to promote balanced global growth and prosperity through knowledge-sharing. The largest business forum in Asia, the World Knowledge Forum brings together global leaders to address the importance of knowledge in meeting the challenges and opportunities of a rapidly changing world.

The World Knowledge Forum was conceived as part of the Vision Korea Project, a campaign launched by Maeil Business Newspaper in 1997 to propose new visions for development to Korea and to the global community. The first World Knowledge Forum, entitled 'Shaping the New Millennium with Knowledge,' took place in 2000, shortly after the Asian financial crisis. Partnering with the Financial Times, Bloomberg, Nikkei and CNBC, the Forum has since grown to encompass 90 sessions featuring 200 panelists from all over the world.
